The National Conference for Building and Facility Operations (NCBFO) is an annual Canadian conference hosted by the Western and Eastern Canadian Chapters since 2014. NCBFO 2026 will be the leading forum for individuals interested in the continuous improvement in operations of buildings and facilities.

 - Roof Replacements
 - Digitalization and Controls

Abstracts shall be submitted by email and include the following.

- Session title.
- Type of session (e.g., presentation, workshop, panel, etc.).
- Names of the presenter(s), their titles, and their associated companies.
- Max 300-word summary presenting the problem statement, the methodology, and the findings.

Note that all sessions will be in person and could be either in French or English. We are pleased to offer free conference registration to all our selected presenters, but please note that you will still be responsible for your own travel and accommodation arrangements (we will shortly be providing more information about negotiated conference rates at the hotel).
